Purpose of Religion: According to Genesis, the first book of the Bible, man was

What was the reason that God and man became disconnected? It was sin. Because
of sin, man broke off from God, who is life, and as a result, death entered into the
world. However, God has been working to restore the world that has been
corrupted. It was not His will to leave mankind, who are like His, children in
death. Therefore, the aim and the purpose of religion are to reconnect the God and
